

**THE BASSETLAW DISTRICT COUNCIL**  
**(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)**  
**ORDER 2013**

**NOTICE OF MAKING OF ORDER**

Notice is hereby given that on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2013 Bassetlaw District Council made an order in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to:

1. Revoke the Bassetlaw District Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2008.
2. Make the Bassetlaw District Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 (“the Order”).
3. To include a full schedule of parking places and scale of charges within the Order itself. The scale of charges itself is unchanged.
4. To make minor amendments in the text of the Order to clarify conditions of use and to prevent misuse of the car parks. A summary of the principal amendments are;
  - (a) To define the scale of charges payable at a parking place as those “advertised at that parking place and specified in the Schedule to this Order as amended from time to time”
  - (b) To clarify how a Pay and Display ticket or Parking Permit should be exhibited on a vehicle so that it is facing forwards “so that the front of the ticket showing the date, time of expiry and amount paid is clearly visible/ can be easily seen and read from the outside of the vehicle”.

The Order shall come into force on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2013.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
