Review of Licensing Policy

Bassetlaw District Council is currently reviewing its statement of licensing policy, which it is required to do every five years. As part of that review the Council is consulting upon the contents of its draft policy.

The draft policy reflects recent amendments made to the licensing legislation. It also seeks to address concerns expressed about the impact of licensable activities in particular areas upon antisocial behaviour and the fear of crime. This is balanced against the benefits of vibrant, well-managed premises, which are essential to the continued success of the district.
