LI releases new guidance on visual representation of development proposals

Please note: TGN 06/19 is currently under review. Following an extensive process, the LI Technical Committee has published Technical Guidance Note (**TGN) 06/19: Visual Representation of development proposals** – the long-awaited refresh of our Photography and Photomontage guidance (01/11). Though the change in title reflects the emergence of different technologies, the focus of the guidance remains on the core photography-based methods used by most practitioners. (Detailed guidance on some emergent technologies may be the subject of a future workstream.) The publication of the TGN follows extensive consultation with LI members and technical experts in photography, photomontage and landscape and visual impact assessment.

Your work: Adopting and adapting to the new guidance

The LI's view is that **TGN 06/19** should apply to new commissions from this point on, but that a reasonable



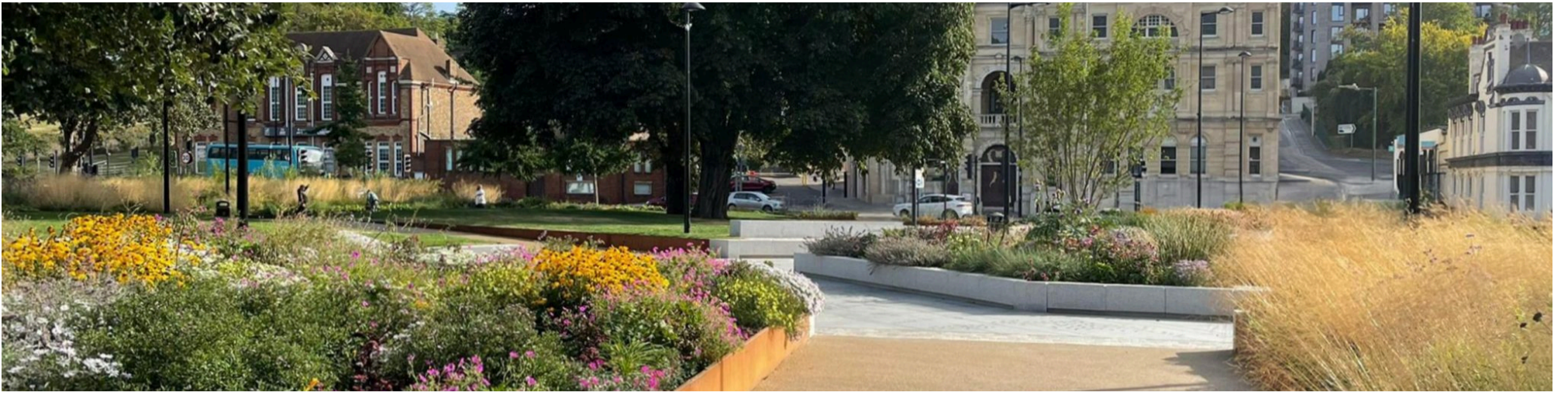
