Proposal Town And Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment)
Regulations 2017 - Screening Opinion – Proposed 40 Mw Solar Farm

I refer to your current planning enquiry, regarding the above, and the request for a screening opinion to be issued.

The proposed development falls within the description in Schedule 2, Paragraph 3(a), industrial installations for the production of electricity, steam and hot water to the 2017 Regulation and meets the criteria set out in column 2 of the table of that Schedule.

However Bassetlaw District Council as the relevant Local Planning Authority, having taken into account the criteria set out in Schedule 3 to the 2017 Regulations, is of the opinion that the development, would not be likely to have a significant effect on the environment by virtue of factors such as its nature, size and location.

Accordingly the Authority has adopted the opinion that the development referred to above for which planning permission is sought is not EIA development as defined in the 2017 regulations.
