Proposal: The proposed development includes a range of environmental improvements to the existing site. These include:

1. Re-design of the existing car park, pedestrian access arrangements and associated landscaping / picnic area. New design to include tarmac surface and lighting.
2. Repairs and refurbishment to existing perimeter paths.
3. Replace two flights of existing sleeper steps plus handrails.
4. Repairs to failing metal/timber sleeper wall, including replacement of worst section with new gabion cage retaining wall.
5. 25 no. new fishing platforms to include 2 x wheelchair accessible and safe platforms.
6. Disabled access ramps from perimeter path to 2 disabled fishing platforms.
