### **Key Achievements:**

The PubWatch webpage for displaying photographic information about banned persons. This enables doormen to access the list whilst on duty and prevent disturbances. It also enable members to communicate outside of meetings.

The extension of the designated public place order has meant that Victoria Square is now included in the alcohol free zone.

Through the Community Safety Team funding has been gained for Domestic Violence work and Women's Aid.

### **Reasons for non-implementation of Recommendations:**

Recommendation 1. Nottinghamshire Police have decided to continue with Operation Abridge and Animsim as these have been successful in reducing violence and disorder around the night time economy in the town centre by 25%.

Recommendation 3. PubWatch is run by landlords and since the review there have been changes in the Chair. The Licensing Officer Sara Luke is no longer involved but the local Beat Officers are. Although PubWatch has not extended the area it covers, there is capacity for this to change with the introduction of the Pubwatch Worksop webpage which allows Members of Pubwatch to access photographs of those banned and are able to message and communicate with other members of the group. This is overseen by the Beat Officers.

Recommendation 7. There is no Force wide procedure in place to record alcohol in Domestic Violence incidents. Alcohol 1,2,3 referral scheme in place at Bassetlaw locally for ASB only.

Recommendation 9. The re-structuring of Nottinghamshire Police has made co-location not possible as the Licensing Officers are based in Mansfield and Newark.
