61. Tinkers Lane.

This meeting was to discuss the situation at the Copse on Tinkers Lane where anti frackers have set up camp on parish land.

A general discussion took place and it was agreed that as the Parish Council did not want the squatters on parish land we should do the following.

Obtain a possession order.

Once this has been achieved and if the squatters ignore it we should take legal action as to their eviction.

The Chair has contacted the council's insurers Came & Co. Who in turn passed him on to the policy holder AXA Commercial they informed him that we are covered for legal liability and will send the paper work in the post, there would be an £250.00 excess to the claim.

The Clerk to check with N.A.L.C. regarding any information about registering the Village Hall, Playing Field & the Copse on Tinkers Lane with the Land Registry, is something we can do ourselves or must we have to use a solicitor.

If we can do it then can we ask Jones & Co. for a bill regarding work carried out.

It has been noted that the 30mph sign on the A634 Blyth Road seems to have been moved further towards the village as it is now near the Copse on Tinkers Lane. The Clerk to Contact the police to see if they have done it or has it been moved by another party.
