07/0415	<p>ORGANISATIONAL REPORTS Councillor Hadley updated the Council regarding the new process for speedwatch which was to educate drivers by using the electronic speed boards, a training session should have been held in January but he has not heard anything since. He also told us that the speed guns and jacket are still available if anyone wants to help out. A notice will be placed in the STAR to advertise this. Playfield Report Burial Board Report – There were no members of the burial board at the meeting.</p>														
08/0415	<p>ELECTIONS BRIEFING There will be no election in Torworth as not all the seats on the council have been applied for.</p>														

09/0415	<p>RURAL CONFERENCE BRIEFING Councillor Willis updated the council on the conference at Retford Town Hall, the main point was the big budget cuts in the Police, they are looking to change the way of policing and have a centralised response unit between Retford and Worksop. They are also looking to develop a Parish Constable who would be trained like a special. Paddy Tipping said there were 140 parishes in Notts and the Police should attend the meetings where possible. DCSI Carolyn Ratcher updated on Rural Crime and Wildlife Crime, there is a rural crime working group which is quite small at the minute, they are installing ANPR cameras in key towns, which has been quite successful with gangs.</p>
10/0415	<p>WEBSITE There will be some funding available from NALC to help with this but it is unsure how much yet, Cllr Willis will contact someone from the CBF at Sutton who could help with this.</p>
11/0415	<p>CENTRAL BASSETLAW FORUM Cllr Willis updated the Council on the CBF, they are looking into a joint speedwatch group as all the villages are struggling for volunteers they could initially have one from each village to start it up. Joint internal audits – the clerk does not wish to take part in this. Joint Grass Cutting – the council agreed to look into getting a price but were also slightly concerned that this may not be economical for Torworth. Regarding the litter that is on Daneshill Road, another County Councillor said that if it is from the landfill site it should be paid for by them, Clerk to contact Wendy Turner to investigate this.</p>
12/0415	<p>NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN The neighbourhood plan has been developed under the localism act to develop and shape the area, it is there to guide people rather than prevent development, it will be a statutory document and has to complement what BDC has as their vision for us. Natalie Cockrell will attend our meeting possibly in June to discuss this further.</p>
13/0415	<p>PLANNING 15/00328/LBA Carry out repairs to the roof of two outbuildings, Manor Farm, Great North Road, Torworth – No objections 15/00237/FUL Remove existing wooden porch to property and insert a new door and window to shop front. – No objections 15/00263/FUL Erect two dormer bungalows with detached garages, High Gables, North Road, Torworth – The PC objects this due to issues with access onto the highway, a similar application was also refused previously.</p>
