02/0216	<p><b>POLICE/CRIME FIGURES</b></p> <p>PCSO Dave Airey attended the meeting, he reported that January had been crime free and in December there had been 2 reported crimes, one criminal damage and one burglary other. He stressed that people should call 101 for all non emergency problems. He advised that there have been a number of rogue traders going around people should be wary of people they are not expecting. The Police have issued the Parish Council with some no uninvited callers stickers, UV pens and light timers. If anyone is interested Councillor C Willis has these. PCSO Airey also told the PC that shed alarms are still available to purchase from Clarborough, Wheatley and North Leverton, priced between £5 and £10. Councillor Willis stated that the PC are in no way responsible for any criminal matters or activity within the village and people with concerns should contact 101.</p>
