06/0516	POLICE/CRIME FIGURES There were no police representatives present at the meeting. At the meeting a report had not yet been received and would be forwarded to the Councillors once it arrived.
07/0516	DISTRICT / COUNTY COUNCILLOR Councillor M Gray was not at the meeting, Councillor C Willis updated the meeting that she had put in a complaint to Bassetlaw District Council regarding the lack of attendance by Councillor Gray over the last 15 months, and the fact that there is no district representation for all of the Igas issues that are ongoing. BDC have confirmed they have received the letter but that there is a procedure to follow. County Councillor Liz Yates presented a report to the Council which she has sent a copy of to be included in the next STAR, she also discussed the Sheffield City combined authority agreement, which there is a petition to sign, a link to this will be put in the next STAR. Regarding a recent process to be introduced by BDC to register to use the local tip, L Yates suggested we send the letter of complaint to the Chief Exec, Anthony May and Head of the Council Alan Rhodes. Councillor C Willis asked Liz if there was anything she could do about putting a new street lamp near the entrance to the playfield for health and safety reasons, this was something Liz would take up with Notts Highways again.

This is not for protestors but for residents to come along and ask questions of various different agencies without any pressure and to gain information, leaflets will be dropped around the village, there will be another session at Sutton Village Hall on 4th June.</p> <p>The visit to Doe Green at Warrington was last Monday and Cllr C Willis reported this was a very worthwhile visit as it looks exactly the same as a fracking site, lots of questions were asked and all the questions were answered, there are lots of pictures which will go on the Tinker Lane website and Torworth information pages. The footprint was not as large as expected.</p>

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12/0516	<p>AMENITIES AND FACILITIES</p> <p>The PC have got some grey metal paint from Veolia to paint the playfield gates, a couple of local teenagers would be willing to paint it, a fee for this needs to be discussed.</p> <p>Hilary Skelton has got some quotes for a new playfield gate, it was discussed whether one should be purchased but it was finally decided to wait to see what funding is available from the Igas site at Daneshill as they may be able to purchase something more suitable as they are extremely expensive.</p> <p>Councillor J Helliwell has been to Retford Readymix to ask about some concrete to set the new bench in the playpark, they have said they would be happy to donate some to the PC. The Parish Council would like to thank them for this.</p> <p>The PC will meet next Sunday to discuss where the bench should go and Councillor R Willis will look into the steelwork for this.</p> <p>The Scarecrow Festival is fast approaching on Sunday 12th June, there will be lots of things this year as they have received a grant. To celebrate the Queens 90th Birthday there will be a Children’s Street Party at 3pm, bookings will be required for this. Due to the new dog laws all dogs will need to be on a lead when they are not in the agility.</p>
