It was reported that a car had been broken into in Torworth and that the thieves had tried to steal it.</p>
03/1016	<p>DISTRICT / COUNTY COUNCILLOR</p> <p>County Councillor L Yates reported that the Misson Planning application would be heard at Notts County tomorrow, and that there had been a last minute attempt by the Wildlife Trust and Friends of the Earth to stop the application by referring to a covenant on the missile site. Councillor Yates was disappointed that Notts Planning Officers recommend the application to be approved with no objections but did state they have to follow national planning policy. It will be down to the planning committee to pass the application, if not it will go to appeal then it will go to the Government.</p> <p>Councillor Yates is still awaiting news of the Sheffield region.</p> <p>Regarding the form from the tip in which Councillor Yates stated it no longer asks for date of birth, the form does still ask for it but people are not obliged to give it.</p> <p>Regarding the streetlight on Holds Lane & Cycle races Councillor Yates has still not heard anything but will push for this.</p> <p>Veolia have been instructed to ensure vehicles going into and out of the site are covered.</p>
