The Meeting of Norton and Cuckney Parish Council held in the Norton Cuckney Village Hall on the 9 March 2016 at 7.30pm.

176/15 Present: Councillors Collins (Chairman), M Smith, Alvey, J Reynolds, G Smith, Morton and Barlow.

177/15 To accept and approve apologies for absence

Apologies for absence had been received from Councillor Brailsford and these were accepted.

178/15 To receive and record any declaration of interest from members in any item to be discussed

Councillors Collins, M Smith and G Smith expressed declaration of interest in agenda item 11.

179/15 To approve minutes of the meeting held 10 February 2016

Councillor Alvey proposed to accept the minutes of the meeting held 10 February 2016 as a true record; with the exception that the footpath sign referred to in minute 155/15 was infact a road sign and the date of the next meeting had been quoted as 11 March 2016 in minute 175/15; this was seconded by Councillor M Smith. The minutes were signed and dated by the Chairman.

180/15 To receive any updates from the minutes of the meeting held 10 February 2016

 Bassetlaw District Councillor Dukes reported that he had had a twitter conversation with the Royal Mail who would be contacting the Clerk.
 The Clerk reported that no contact from Royal Mail had been received.
 Bassetlaw District Councillor Dukes agreed to follow this up again.

Minute 095/15

• The Chairman reported that Tesco customers would have the opportunity to vote for the Community Garden scheme, against two others this week, which would determine whether the grant awarded would be £8,000, £10,000 or £12,000. All Grantscape bids had been approved. Works on each project required completion by October 2016. Councillor G Smith and Alvey agreed to co-ordinate on the Mill

Hill and toughs/railings projects; Councillor Collins agreed to coordinate the Community Garden project. The Clerk agreed to clarify Vat implications.

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Minute 165/15

Councillor Alvey reported that a strimmer had been purchased. A photo call with BDC was to be confirmed. The Clerk would forward a name to Councillor Alvey with regards to training for strimmer use.
 Action – Clerk. Councillor Barlow agreed to approach HSE with regards to strimming/brushcutting and works by the road side. Action – Councillor Barlow.

 The Clerk reported the need for two salt bins had been referred to Nottinghamshire County Council (NCC).

 The Clerk reported that following NCC's response that farming soil on the A60 did not meet their criteria the complaint had been resubmitted pointing out that the drains in this area were blocked and that the mud was a slip hazard. Photos had also been sent. Councillor M Smith reported that the old council yard gate had now been secured with new chain.

181/15 Open session for members of the public to speak

County Councillor Ogle reported on Welbeck Colliery meeting and BDC's satellite broadband scheme.

District Councillor Dukes reported that BDC were holding an extra ordinary meeting to decide whether the district should join Sheffield City Region or stay with the D2N2 bid. District Councillor Dukes reminded Councillors that a third wireless broadband option was available.

183/15 To discuss skip provision Norton and Cuckney

The Clerk reported on skip hire charges. Councillor Morton had been quoted a considerably cheaper price from BDC of £88. It was agreed that a skip should be ordered for Norton for the weekend of 23/24 April 2016. Action – Councillor Morton.

184/15 To discuss playing field lease and inspection

Councillor Barlow reported that the playing field lease showed that the Council was responsible for the playing field fence. After discussion, **it was agreed that** the Council would carry out the repairs to the fence. The lease had expired but the rent was still being paid and this being the case the lease was holding over until one side decided to terminate it. After discussion, **it was agreed that**, there was no requirement to alter this arrangement. Councillor Alvey presented quotes for the annual playground inspection. **It was agreed that**, Wickstead would be appointed to do the inspection. Concerns were expressed about the fencing by the hydro generator. Councillor Alvey agreed to speak with Robin Brown at Welbeck.
