1.26.11.2019 POLICE REPORT

2.26.11.2019 DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

There were no specific declaration of interests on this occasion

3.26.11.2019 MINUTES OF PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

The meeting of the Parish Council Meeting **24th September 2019** as circulated were agreed and signed as a true and correct record.

Cllr Bowker subsequently reported that a letter had been sent to the occupier of 25 Pagdin Drive regard to fencing BUT as the case was over 2yrs old no action could be taken.

4.26.11.2019 CORRESPONDENCE

It was reported that John Mann had now taken up his seat in the House of Lords. A General Election was scheduled for 12th December that would incorporate the Vacancy for MP for Bassetlaw.

Cllr David Smith had sent a Freedom of Information request to the Notts County Council re data from the Oldcotes Cross Roads installation.

5.26.11.2019 STREET MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

6.26.11.2019 PLANNING MATTERS

7.26.11.2019 WAYSIDE SEATS

It was agreed to leave the siting of the remaining seat on the Styrrup Playing Field to the local residents subject to the seat not being located under any trees.**(Action Jo Walker)**

8.26.11.2019 STYRRUP VILLAGE HALL

The Water Meter had now been located by Water-Plus and a refund credit note received.

The leak to the extension roof had re-emerged and Jo Walker was contacting the roofer for remedial action.

Further plumbing work to the toilets had been quoted for and approved.

9.26.11.2019 ACCOUNTS

The Clerk reported that all accounts and invoices had been settled and no outstanding matters held over. Work to the Pinfold Garden in the sum of £870 including VAT had been ordered and was pending completion as an extension to the grass cutting contract.

10.24.09.2019 MEMBERS ITEMS

1. Cllr Morton reported an annual visit by the mechanical road sweeper to Oldcotes.
2. Cllr Reynolds had injured his eye and apologised for not attending the Seasonal Refreshments event but had made provision via Cllr Bland
3. Cllr Earle reported that the rear room of the Styrrup V H had been booked for the Central Bassetlaw Forum. (5th December 2019)

4. Cllr P Browne reported that he had represented the Parish Council by laying a wreath at the Oldcotes Memorial on the 10th November 2019.

5. Cllr Smith's request for a 2 plug power take off socket be provided from a street light on Main Street to the Oldcotes Pinfold Garden had received a negative response from VIA East Midlands and NCC. Alternative suggestions were made.

6. Cllr Browne A request for assistance with the purchase of a Christmas Tree and lights for Display in Styrrup was approved in the sum of £200. To Styrrup Residents Action Group. Clerk to be supplied with Bank Details for a BACS payment.

7. Cllr Weldon referred to a significant number of Lorries using the village after visiting the Building Supplies Unit that had commenced at The Former Glass Bulbs site. Members would attempt to establish where they were visiting prior to contact through formal channels.
