A low circular mound, 30m diam with a max height of 0.9m, much reduced by ploughing.

Much ploughed out tumulus with signs of ditch 28yds in diam, 3ft high. (3)

A rectangular area is enclosed around the barrow leaving the mound unploughed in the future works (sic). However the mound is now populated by weeds and willowherb and some small shrubs and trees are colonizing the area. Mound is reduced but measures 8m diameter by ? 0.45m high.
