

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP AND DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

**SECTION 257 (1 ) (a) TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

**SHIREOAKS PUBLIC FOOTPATHS NUMBERS 22 AND 23 (LAND AT EXPLORE INDUSTRIAL PARK ,STEETLEY LANE , RHODESIA WORKSOP, NOTTINGHAMSHIRE)**

**STOPPING UP AND DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

An application for planning permission in respect of development was granted on the 24<sup>th</sup> May 2018 for the creation of a car park ,and a new access road with lighting at Explore Industrial Park Steetley Lane , Rhodesia , Worksop , Nottinghamshire under planning reference 18/00676/FUL To enable the development to go ahead it will be necessary to authorise the Stopping Up and Diversion of Shireoaks Public Footpaths Numbers 22 and 23 .

Accordingly, the above Order was made on the 8<sup>TH</sup> October 2018 under section 257(1) (a) of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 to enable the following :-

The two footpaths being Shireoaks Footpath Number 22 from point A ( SK 5499 7994 ) to point B ( SK 5512 7908 ) and Shireoaks Footpath Number 23 from point B ( SK 5512 7908 ) to point C ( SK 5486 7921 ) over the land shown by continuous black lines on the Order plan with approximate lengths of 182 metres and 270 metres respectively as described in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Order shall be stopped up and diverted .

There shall be created, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council, one alternative bridleway as shown by a hatched line on the Order plan with an approximate lengths of 775 metres between point D ( SK 5479 7913 ) and point E ( SK 5524 7953 ) and one alternative footpath as shown by a dotted line on the Order plan with an approximate length of 197 metres between point F ( SK 5506 7925 ) to point B (SK 5512 7908 ) as replacements for the two footpaths as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to the Order

The width of the diverted footpath shall be 2.0 ( two ) metres and the width of the bridleway shall be 3.0 ( three ) metres .

Full details of the stopping up and diversions are as described on the Order and defined on the Order Map.

Copies of the Order and Order Map may be inspected free of charge at Bassetlaw District Council, Planning Department, Queen's Buildings, Potter Street, Worksop, S80 2AH during normal office hours, Monday to Friday (9.00 am to 5.00 pm).

Copies of the Order and Order Map may be purchased at the total price of £5.

Any representations about, or objections to the Order may be sent to the Interim Development Team Manager, Planning Department Bassetlaw District Council, Queen's Buildings, Potter Street, Worksop, S80 2AH to be received no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018 . Please state the grounds on which representations or objections are made.

If no such representations or objections are made, or if any so made are withdrawn , Bassetlaw District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order.

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
