**15/001 Highways/Road Safety:** PE has drafted a letter to Robert Jenrick in connection with the continuing problems of the issues– waiting approval from Cllr Hynes before being sent. PE has been informed this was a Police matter and was not their problem. PE has contacted Paul Hillier from BDC with regards a new sign – no reply yet. It is proposed that new speed sign will be placed on the corner of Grange Place. 20 mph stickers to be purchased for relevant Main Street residents to stick to wheelie bins hoping to slow traffic down. 50 x stickers @ £90. Cllr Barnes proposed, seconded by Cllr Stothard. All in favour.

**15/022 Neighbourhood Watch:** The Parish Council have been made aware of an issue at Dorma Cottage with a resident absconding causing the Carers to search the village for the individual over a period of 2 days.
